Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting funding in the amount of \$2,500,000.00 for Raw Water Intake Improvements Project for the Town of Pulaski, Virginia in fiscal year 2027.

The entity to receive this funding is the Town of Pulaski, Virginia, with offices located at 3593 Case Knife Road, Pulaski, Virginia 24301.

This funding is an appropriate use of taxpayer dollars because it will upgrade critical infrastructure at the Town's Water Treatment Plant raw water intake facility. The proposed project includes installation of new intake screens, replacement of raw water pumps, and improvements to the airburst system to improve treatment reliability and system performance.

These improvements are necessary to address deficiencies identified under a Virginia Department of Health Consent Order related to disinfection byproduct levels and to maintain compliance with state and federal drinking water standards. The project will protect safe drinking water for Pulaski residents and surrounding Pulaski County customers served by the system while strengthening infrastructure reliability.

This project has a Federal nexus because it is for the purposes authorized in the Byrne Justice Assistance Grants (JAG) program, section 501 of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (34 U.S.C. § 10152).
